Common Keyboard Shortcuts

Keyboard shortcuts help boost productivity and save time when working on your computer. To use a keyboard shortcut, press and hold the first key(s), then press the last key of the shortcut, and then release all keys. Here are some common Microsoft Windows keyboard shortcuts:


Ctrl + C *Copy* and **Ctrl + V** *Paste*: Select or highlight the item you want to copy, and press Ctrl + C. You can paste it elsewhere using Ctrl + V.

Ctrl + Z *Undo*: Made a mistake? Ctrl + Z will undo your most recent action. It works whether you're typing, editing a photo, or even moving files.

Ctrl + A *Select All*: This shortcut selects all text, files, or items in a window or document. It's useful when you need to copy or delete everything at once.

Ctrl + + *Zoom In*, **Ctrl + -** *Zoom Out*, and **Ctrl + 0** *Reset Zoom*: These shortcuts allow you to adjust the zoom level of your web browser.

Alt + Tab *Switch Between Open Programs*: Hold Alt and press Tab to cycle through your open programs.

Many of these shortcuts work on a Mac by replacing the first keystroke with the Apple **command**  key. For more help with keyboard shortcuts, ask one of our Tech Librarians!
