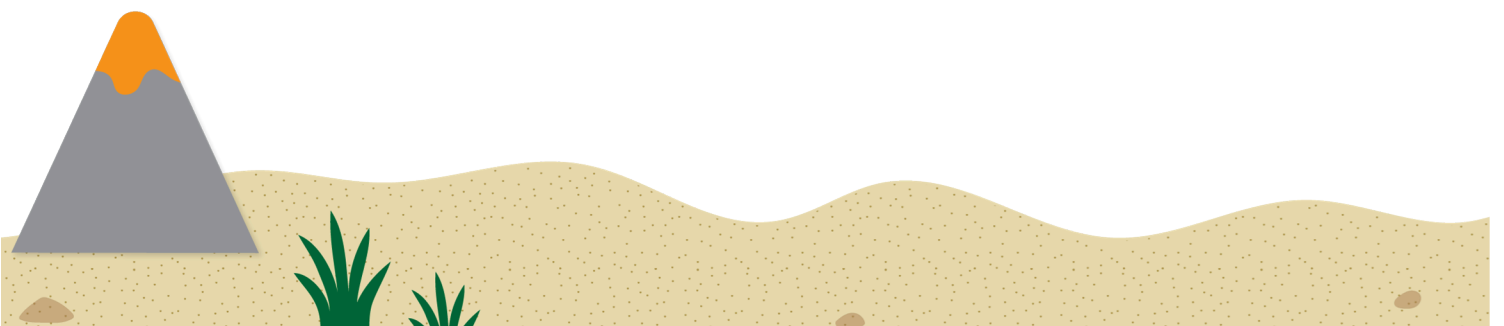
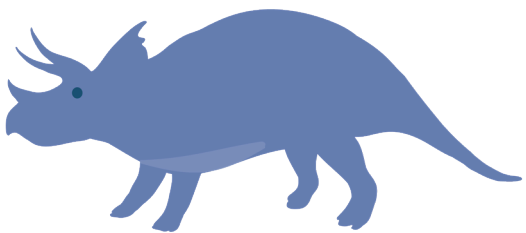
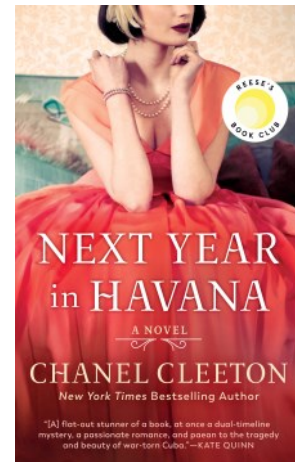
Military Memories
